#### **Church Board Highlights**

August 18, 2025

Cindy Batdorf was present to discuss the operation of the stoves and ovens at the Fellowship Hall. She stated that they don't seem to stay hot enough and food takes longer to cook than it should. The Board approved to have Blue Mountain Mechanical come out to take a look.

Cindy also spoke about the recent Fundraising Committee meeting where they discussed the purchase of a used cabbage chopper from Brubakers for \$3,500 plus \$350 for a cart. This is a total cost of \$3,850 to be paid from the Fundraising Account. This machine is about the same as what Plum Creek uses and Cindy went to see theirs in action. This new chopper will reduce labor when it comes to dealing with making pepper cabbage and could have some additional uses. The Board approved this purchase.

Treasurer Larry Henne reported that in July the 2024 UCC dividends and capital gains in the amount of \$36,382 was turned over to the Joint Board to help with expenses.

It was reported that Pastor Kevin has vacation from August 31 – September 13 and James has vacation from September 25-30.

Property Committee reported that the LED lights have been installed at the Fellowship Hall and the last section of lighting to be installed is in the chapel at church. They are also meeting with Dave Weidenhammer to look over some repointing needs at the church and looking into some options on making some repairs to the Church Parking lot.

Pastor Kevin asked if the church has a procedure for receipt of larger designated gifts such as the one for the repairs of the old church organ and thought it would be best to have a board action to receive the donation. The board approved to accept the anonymous gift to be designated to the Old Church Organ Repairs.

James Fitterling noted that we will likely end up right around \$5,000 in donations for the scholarship in memory of Jim Holcombe. We will be doing some looking into what some other churches have done to setup a Scholarship Fund like this.

James also reported that he was contacted by Tompkins about the Church safe deposit box and noted that Gladys Staab was technically the only name on it and that it should be updated. The Board approved to add Larry Henne, Carla Rozsitch and James Fitterling to it.

Lastly, with the recent barn fire at Jake Leiby's farm the Board approved a \$500 donation from the Heffner Tithe to Jake Leiby.

or someone you know would be interested in attending classes, be sure to **come to the first meeting!** 




