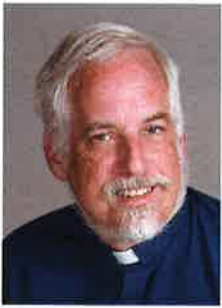

Pastor's Ponderings

I write this on April 1. April Fool's day. I mention this, because I have a special memory of that day, some almost 50 years ago.

Roxan was the girl next door. We were both in sixth grade that year, and she was I guess a kind of "proto-girlfriend." In any case we hung out a lot. We played with dolls and hot wheels, swam in

her pool and took some sledge hammers and demolished a shed on her property, with the help of her brothers. I don't think we actually asked permission to do that! Oops!

We were friends and a bit of puppy love was in the air.

So, in early spring we got our school pictures. And as was the custom, the kids always got a page of wallet sized pictures to hand out to friends. I went over to her house one day, and she had something special for me. A wallet sized school picture, from "Your Friend, Roxan."

For a girl to give a boy a signed school picture in 6th grade, was not something to be taken lightly. It really meant something, that something was blossoming, that somehow, she liked me! I was special, could it be love? And I had all those preadolescent warm feelings for her as well. So maybe.....

So not to brag (lol), I walked the corridors of my school showing all the guys my special picture of the girl next door. "Look what Roxan gave me! Her picture! I think she likes me! I think she likes me! Do you think she likes me?" And all of this was going really swell until one guy noticed something I had missed. "Nah, I don't think so, look at the date."

I checked out the back of the picture, and above the message was written the date she gave me the picture.

April 1.

So, this kid had put doubt in my head. Why did Roxan use that date? Why not date it March 31 or April 2? Was this a sincere gift of affection.....or an April fool's prank? I just could not sweep the doubt away.

But deep in my heart, I did know the truth. We were friends, and she proved that to me every time we got together to hang out or play.

We can have doubts put in our head all the time. And sometimes they are life changing. Like when we listen to certain people, or read certain books or articles that doubt the resurrection. That claim that Jesus, did not rise from the dead. That rather it was but a symbolic detail, that did not happen, but was written into the Gospels as allegory or something. It's as IF Jesus rose from the dead.

But as we approach Easter, the resurrection, let us not get dragged into doubt. Let us live as our faith tells us. Let us rely on the promises of the Gospel. We know that Jesus rose!! We know in our hearts!! We sing of the glorious truth!!

Thine Is the glory! Risen conquering Son! Endless is the victory! Though o'er Death has won!

## Church Board Highlights

March 18, 2019

- Rev. Mary Gade was present to conduct a one year review of Pastor Dave's ministry at Belleman's. Rev. Gade was thanked for her years of service and wished well on her upcoming retirement.
- Treasurer, Larry Henne reported that the spring taxes and annual church insurance have been paid.
- The property committee has been trying to fix a problem with the dusk to dawn light at the back of the parking lot. It keeps tripping the breaker with no obvious causes. They will next plan to swap out the breaker and see if that fixes the issue.
- The Capital Campaign reported that the profit from the Chicken BBQ is \$2,310.
- The Lift youth group had their meeting on March 10. They discussed the June Mission Trip and a few more youth have expressed interest in going. They also began preparations for Youth Sunday on April 28. Following the Youth service that day there will be a fundraiser to help fund the Wildwood retreat which will be the following weekend from May 4-6. The youth will once again work to put together Easter Baskets for the Children's Home of Reading.
- The Board voted to include Council/Consistory members and spouses in the leadership dinner meeting prior to Consecration Sunday.
- Pastor Dave reported that our community meal has been advertised at the last two community meals and at the SV food pantry. It was noted that we would like helpers starting at around 3:30 p.m. on April 16. A signup sheet will be posted to get others involved with serving this meal as well as asking for donations of cakes/desserts.
- Donations in memory of Alma Klinger were designated to Belleman's in lieu of flowers. Lonnie Klinger did not stipulate to what he would like the money used for and said the Board should use it as needed. The Board approved for the \$415 of donations to go to the Capital Campaign.
- The Board approved to give up to \$200 from the Heffner Tithe to the Smile Fund.

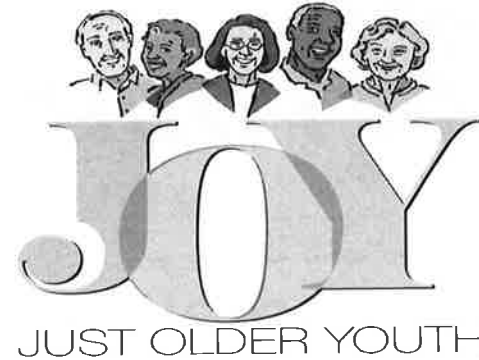

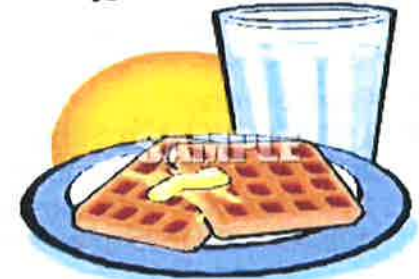
