

IMPORTANT NOTICE!

On Monday, July 1 at 3:28 p.m. the surveillance camera in the church office captured an unknown individual entering the office and then leaving. The person left the premises before James or the sextons got to the church. As far as we could tell, nothing of value was stolen. The church doors were examined and all were locked. It was discovered however that the east side door could be forced open if it was pulled hard enough. The assumption at this point is that this is how the person gained entry. In response to this. the door has been secured from the inside and will be temporarily unusable. Dutch Valley Window and Door has examined the door as well and repair/replacement options will be discussed. In the meantime, all church doors will remain locked at all times. In order to enter the church during the week, please call James in the church office. Also, as was the case last summer, when we have church in the sanctuary, the only doors unlocked for church will be the doors entering the sanctuary both from the front steps and the ramp. If anyone has any questions or concerns, please contact the church office.

Church Board Highlights

June 17, 2024

Treasurer, Larry Henne presented and reviewed his written report. He noted that the amount of \$7,824 had been transferred out of the treasury to the Old Church account. This is the amount of insurance proceeds and donation toward the window repairs at the old church which was received at the end of last year. He also noted about an expense on the report in the amount of \$415.01 which was for some supplies for work being done on the bandstand. This work is being completed by the Scouts and Mike Harle who replaced some railings.

The board approved the rates for Rev. Barry Spatz of \$100 per Sunday for supply preaching and \$20 per hour for any pas-

toral emergency visits.

A Memorial Day Picnic report was presented which shows a profit of \$2,998.83. This is a great success in spite of the unsettled weather on Memorial Day and having to cancel the band.

The Property Committee reported that the Church roof project was approved by the congregation with the vote held on June 9 with a vote of 46 yes and 1 no. The plan is for this project to take place during the first week of August. Also, James Fitterling reported that the WiFi upgrades have been completed as far as all installations of wiring and hardware. Next, will be to look into an upgraded internet service.

Call Committee reported that they have received a second applicant and have completed initial interviews with both candidates so far. Second interviews for both are being planned.

It was reported that the Anniversary celebration was well liked by all in attendance. Attendance for the service was 88. Offering collected at the service was around \$500 which will help offset the cost of the meal. Also, the sale of the Anniversary bricks has gone well, with only a few remaining of the first batch. Proceeds from the sale of bricks will go to Maya Hein and her family as she gets her cancer treatments.

The Hope Rescue Mission made contact with us again about holding a clothing drive. This drive will be held through July 14. James noted that he already gave them the go ahead that we would do it.
