

#### Church Board Highlights May 20, 2024

Treasurer, Larry Henne reviewed his Treasurer report. He noted about a couple expenses under church maintenance. Bills were paid for some mower repairs and for the church emergency lighting which has now been upgraded and is in working order again.

Pastor Pat reviewed her report briefly and highlighted her praise of the Board and her appreciation of the leadership they have for Belleman's. She noted that her last Sunday is May 26, she will be taking part in the Memorial Day Service and her last day in the office will be May 29.

James highlighted the upcoming Worship leader schedule that he has organized for the summer during our time without a pastor. He also noted that Rev. Barry Spatz will be willing to help cover Pastoral Care needs during the time as well. James noted about some compensation for Barry, to include mileage and an honorarium of sorts. This was discussed and James noted that Barry would be making a monthly report to the Board noting his visits. The feeling was to see how much time is involved and make a decision on an honorarium from there. Lastly, Pastor Pat suggested about paying an honorarium as well to our lay leaders when they lead worship. The board agreed to pay lay leaders at the same rate as our Supply Pastors.

The Fundraising Committee included an Oyster dinner report in the meeting packet which shows a profit of \$4,134.78.

The Church roof was discussed and the second quote was higher than the Fisher quote. A third quote was not received after a few contractors declined to provide a bid. With this, the Board approved the proposal by Fisher's Roofing and Siding LLC of \$63,520 for the replacement of the church roof.

The Call Committee reported that they have received the first candidate profile of interest in our Pastor position. They will be beginning the interview process at this point.

The first Community Outreach event of the year was the Hoedown on May 10. It was reported that it was a successful event with approximately 100 attendees. The event was free to the public and a donation was taken for the SV Food Pantry which totaled approximately \$500. Their next event will be the 100<sup>th</sup> church anniversary on June 8.

Plans are underway for this year's VBS. This year is a Camping theme and will take place from July 29- August 1, 2024 in the evenings. The committee will be meeting again in a week to make further plans.

James reported that there is not a ton of news just yet about the church insurance. The last broker we discussed this with has stated about looking at the summertime to begin seeking quotes to see about a new plan by our February 2025 renewal date. One question was about value of buildings and this broker suggested an appraisal as an option. An appraisal company name was furnished to us and a quote of over \$4,000 was received to complete an appraisal of the church, old church, fellowship hall and sexton home. This will be tabled for the time being while we continue to look into our insurance options. A survey of other local congregations was done to see how they handle insurance and at least one other church is also looking to quote out new insurance companies.
