Church Board Highlights - February 17, 2025

The meeting began with Pastor Kevin leading the Board around the church reviewing some ideas and looking into how the appearance of the church can be enhanced.

The following items were approved:

- Minutes from the January 26 Congregational Meeting
- Minutes from the January 27 Board Meeting
- Treasurer Report, subject to Audit
- Pastor Report
- Administrator Report

The Fundraising Committee met to make plans for the Oyster Dinner and Memorial Day. They also had the Soup and Pie sale on February 16 which brought in \$631.

The Property Committee received a lighting plan to upgrade the remaining fluorescent lights to LED. James noted that the new door at church has been installed as well as the door repairs have been completed at the Fellowship Hall.

The Mission Team is finalizing plans for the Mission Trip from March 8-15, 2025 to Asheville, North Carolina.

The Endowment Committee had their annual meeting to approve officers and review the financial report. Their only new business was to transfer the monies from the Gladys Staab bequest from the checking account to the investment portfolio of the Endowment Fund.

James noted the need for volunteers to bring soups and sandwiches for the March 26 Lent lunch at Belleman's. The board divvied out some responsibilities for this.

Also, James questioned whether we would do a Pancake and Sausage breakfast after the Easter Dawn Service on April 20. Two years ago Ken Borkey and Larry Henne took care of this and they agreed to cover it again.

The new Blessing Bag service project was discussed. Carla Rozsitch brought an example of what was discussed last meeting. There was some discussion about how to organize this project as well as working in a Jingle offering to help fund this project. Carla will write a piece for the next newsletter to introduce this to the congregation.

Lastly, there was a suggestion to have gluten free communion bread available. It was noted that the bread on February 16 was all gluten free. After some discussion, it was suggested to switch to completely gluten free bread for Communion services. The board was in agreement.

Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.

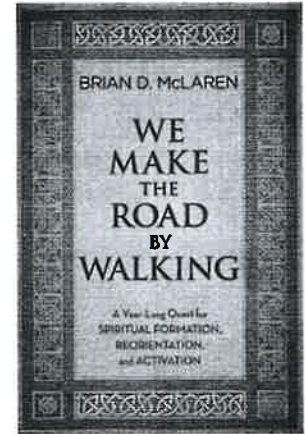
