Church Board Highlights - November 17, 2025

The minutes from the October 20, 2025 Board Meeting and the October Treasurer report were reviewed and approved.

Pastor Kevin noted that he is looking toward getting meetings of the Finance, Projects and Old Church Committees scheduled after the holidays are over. The recent Food Pantry drive was a huge success. Pastor Kevin thanked all who came out to help load the items and move them to the pantry. He reported that there was a meeting of the Visitation team to coordinate visits and communions before Christmas. Lastly, Pastor Kevin noted that he has had a number of hospital visitations over the last month.

James Fitterling reported that Brunner and Associates was recently out to do a tuning and minor repairs on the old church organ. This will hopefully keep it going till the rebuild takes place.

Fundraising reported that a finalized Bazaar report was not available, but the profit will come in a bit over \$16,000. Property reported that quotes were not yet received for the Sexton house repairs or potential work to the Parking Lot.

The Community Outreach Committee is planning to have a stand at the Schuylkill Valley Winter Festival on December 7. They have a meeting on November 30 to finalize plans for this and the Old Church Christmas service.

The Worship and Music Committee recently met and reviewed/approved the 2026 calendar for the Board to review. The Board approved the calendar with a few additions.

Frontier recently made contact that the Fiber Optic internet is now ready at the church and will be an over \$80 savings per month. The Board approved to make the move to Frontier Fiber internet.

The Board began work on the 2026 Budget and Larry Henne reviewed some places where adjustments might need to be made. Next the Board reviewed Pastor Kevin's compensation. The board noted that Pastor Kevin has been doing an outstanding job in his first year at Belleman's and with that approved a 4% salary increase for him. In order to have the Budget finalized for the December 14 Congregational Meeting it was suggested to meet briefly after worship on December 7.

It was reported that the Cub Scouts cleaned up some leaves around the grove and Fellowship Hall on November 16.

John Rausch and the Patriotic Order Sons of America are planning a Magic Lantern Show to be held at the Fellowship hall on May 2 and 3, 2026 to commemorate the 250th Anniversary of the USA.
